

Farm Notes.

A well-trained shepherd dog will drive cattle or sheep better than a boy.

Farm and Garden say we are well produce five or six times the amount of strawberries it will wheat.

Isabella, Catawba and Clinton grapes are said to keep well when packed in single layers in shallow boxes, about two inches in depth.

The smallest pony known is the pet of the Baroness Bartlett-Coutts-Bartlett. The pony stands only thirteen inches high, and is five years of age.

Pumpkins, turnips, beets, potatoes and carrots should be sliced when fed to stock, which prevents choking, as danger sometimes occurs when whole or chopped pieces are fed.

Skim-milk, fed with a little oat meal and oats, was found excellent when fed to calves at the Wisconsin Experiment Station. The young animals were kept healthy and growing, but not fat.

November is a good time to set cuttings of grape vines. Plant them in a dry mellow soil at an angle of seventy-five degrees, pack the soil against them, and when the ground freezes cover with a course litter for protection.

Prof. W. J. Beal, in the "Gardener's Monthly," gives some curious eccentricities peculiar to plants. Roots grown in the damp air in the dark will often coil, sometimes two or more of them. If a piece of gummed paper be placed on one side of the root it becomes unusually excited and begins to coil away from the paper, sometimes trying itself into a knot, and often succeeds in rubbing off the paper. Roots generally turn downward, though not always.


