really mean to come -

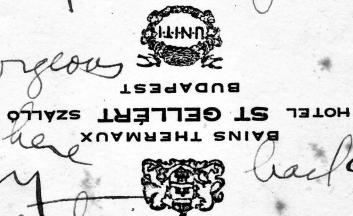
I went to the American
