Dear Mother and Father

We left Geneva at 5, 50. We has a compartment alone until 2,30AM. Some Frenchmen crowded in when the conductor wasn't looking so we did not sleep much after 3AM.

The trip across [illegible] was lovely. We came by Chillon and then [illegible] where they had the big church conference on Faith and [illegible].

When we reached the Munich station at 630 AM there were thousands with knapsacks on their backs and Alpine Costumes. The most stunning blond boys all bareheaded. The women even [illegible] with knapsacks have no sport clothes and are [illegible] as can be but the men are gorgeous. Everywhere we went they were [illegible] or hiking. [illegible] can not doubt the [illegible] of the German people. Yesterday we went by train and boat to Starnburg across a lake and old castle of Ludwig II.

Germany has absolutely disarmed the only country to do what the league asked except one other – Russia. They give free passports and did not open our bags. The mark is high and things more expensive than other countries so we are going to Rija by boat.

Today we went by the Kaiser. Everything on earth. The whole thing [illegible] the German spirit of thoroughness. The whole history of flying from birds to the present [illegible] planes, the same with printing, railroading astronomy and time keeping and chemistry. We couldn't begin to get in it all before we were exhausted. There were thousands of school children. It seems that the German schools only close for 6 weeks in summer and during that time the children go with their teachers on excursions to see the historical place and [illegible].

I tried to buy a wonderful chart of the human body for Randolph but the only ones left were in German and Spanish.

Lois met us at [illegible] which is supposed to be the cradle of Christianity in Russia. A lovely old monastery with catacombs. They showed the coffin of a man which the Bolsheviks had tried to open looking for treasure. Every time they touched it the casket [illegible] burst into flame and drove them away. The [illegible] were covered with pearls emeralds and priceless jewels it being one the of richest monasteries.

There were thousands from the country for the [illegible]-monthly marker. The sort you read about in [illegible] novels.

We reached Tallin again at 7,30 this morning. I went to the Rathouse built in 1400 and to a funeral in a Lutheran church. Lois is having an interview and the vice consul is coming to dinner.

Mothers and Mazies letter came this morning. The lace I have is not for a veil but I can get it in Paris. The duty on a [illegible] cloth use my own judgment. I may have to overdraw. I am going to give Lois a \$200.00 check.
